



English:

This term we will be using a piece of visual literacy (a short film) called "Taking Flight". The story of a young boy who with his Grandad go on an adventure.



We will use this as the stimulus for writing for a range of purposes such as writing our own versions of the story and a diary entry all about their journey. The children will be encouraged to make their writing interesting by using adjectives, powerful vocabulary and by beginning their sentences in different ways.

In the second half of the term, we will start to read *George's Marvellous Medicine* which the children will be bringing home over the summer to continue reading ready for discussion in September with their new teacher..

Creative Curriculum:

Our new topics are called 'Movers and Shakers' and "Coastline".

During the topic 'Movers and Shakers', we will be learning about historically important people who have had a major impact on the world. They will learn to use timelines, stories, and historical sources to find out about the people featured.

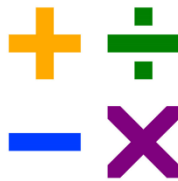
Whilst studying "Coastline" we will be looking at the physical and human features of coastal regions in the UK.



Maths:

This term we will be focusing on:

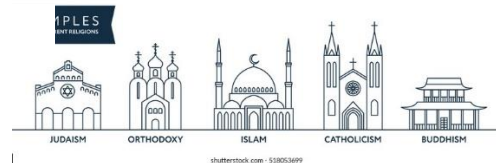
- Length and height
- Position and direction
- Time
- Mass, capacity and temperature



We will also be consolidating the 4 operations, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

In PHSE, we will be learning about different relationships, i.e family, friends and people who help us.

Computing:

We will be completing work using digital film making software.

Our topic this term will be "Plants".

We will be learning about how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants, as well as finding out what plants need to grow and to stay healthy.
