	Write your own story about a butterfly or a frog. What is the setting of your story? Describe the characters. What would the problem be? How would you resolve it? Don't forget to use your brilliant basics!	Who is your favourite monarch? Create a fact file, PowerPoint presentation or collage about your favourite monarch from the past or present. What is their name? What interesting facts can you find out?
