*	Thinking about your favourite animal, draw a picture of it and label it.	In Geography this term we are thinking about what it is like to live in a hot or cold country. Think about countries you may have visited or would like to visit. What is the weather like? Is it a hot country or a cold country? Draw a picture and write captions to describe the country and its weather.
**	Thinking about our Science topic about Animals, write about an animal of your choice. Include a title, and a few short sentences with pictures and labels.	Choose your favourite hot or cold place make a model/collage or drawing of landmarks from that place. Don't tell us the place you have chosen. Can we guess the country/place from the landmarks?

Remembering to use capital letters and full stops.	Comparing Hot or Cold Places the Desert the Arctic Look closely at the pictures of the Arctic and the desert. Write a paragraph comparing the two places. Think about what similarities and differences you can see between them. What animals and plants would live in these places?
