Dear Parents/ Carers,

The week beginning 29<sup>th</sup> March 2021, each class across the school will be taking part in a creative afternoon to celebrate Spring. We are providing children with a creative learning opportunity where they are able to express themselves, in line with this year's mental health theme 'Express Yourself.'
