



Year 1 Summer Term 2024



English:

We will be continuing with our Read Write Inc phonics programme at individual levels.



In reading, we will be continuing to develop the skill of decoding words, as well as reading for understanding and making predictions about what might happen in the story.

We will be looking at stories focussing on characters and settings, information texts and poetry. The children will write in sentences using finger spaces between each word, a capital letter to begin each sentence and correctly punctuated at the end. Our texts will be - Lost and Found, The Elephant and the Bad Baby and Supertato.

Maths:

In maths we will be:



- Continuing to recognise and write numbers to 100 as numerals and words.
- Looking at multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times table.
- Looking at halving and quartering both shapes and a number of objects.
- Position and direction using half and quarter turns.
- Money, recognising and counting coins.
- Telling the time.

Geography

Our topic will be looking at the city of Wolverhampton and what it is like to live there. We will be identifying different landmarks in the locality and comparing and contrasting it with another locality.

History

Our topic will be - How have explorers changed the World? We will be finding out about explorers such as Christopher Columbus and Matthew Henson. Looking at how they travelled and what they found out about the world.

Art/DT

We will be designing and making our own smoothies. In art, we will be exploring colour shades and tones by printing and colour mixing. We will be working in the style of Clarice Cliff.

Music

We will be exploring pitch and tempo using our voices and instruments. We will be singing a range of new and familiar songs.

RE and PSHE

In R.E, we will be exploring the Sikh faith looking at Sikhism in Wolverhampton today.

In PSHE, we will be exploring the topics 'relationships' and 'changing me'.

British Values

We will be looking at tolerance and mutual respect.

Computing:

We will become digital writers using the computer keyboard to type and change text. We will also be programming animations using Scratch Junior.
