- use the language full, empty, half full, nearly full and nearly empty to compare capacity.

- understand different traditions and customs of other cultures.
- talk about animals, plants and natural objects and make observations.

EAD I can ...

- sing songs, make music and dance.
- explore different sounds instruments make.
- use a range of materials to set up a landscape.
