Find all the ways that you can make 10 using 2 numbers and record them, i.e $2+8=10$, $7+3=10$. Can you learn them off by heart?	Go for a walk with an adult, around the local area and record different things that you see, i.e how many post boxes, litter bins, etc? Can you name the types of houses you see...terraced, semi-detached etc? What about wildlife and trees?
	Traction Man is a superhero! Who is your hero? Draw a picture of them and write a few sentences to describe what they do and why you think they are a superhero.	Find all the ways that you can make 20 using 2 numbers and record them eg $13+7=20$ $12+8=20$ Can you learn them off by heart?	Draw a map of your route to school from your house. What roads do you go down? What interesting things do you walk past?
	If you could have a super power, what would it be? Would you be able to fly, become invisible or see through buildings? Write about an adventure you might have. 	Using 2 or 3 dice, can you roll them and then add the numbers together? What's the biggest number you can make and the smallest? Record the numbers that you add. 	How many different routes are there for you to get to school? What is the shortest way and which is the longest? Who can find the most? Record the different routes that you find.
