	Research Julius Caesar and record five facts about him. Was he a king? Where did he come from? Who did he marry? How do you know he was powerful? What did he look like?	Choose a times table and write it out using Roman Numerals.  I II III IV V VI VIII VIII IX X XI XII	Create your own Roman mosaic. Try to be as creative as possible and remember how intricate some of the designs were.
	Create an A to Z of the Roman Empire, with a definition for each word. e.g. A = amphitheatre: the centre of entertainment in Roman times.	Find a traditional Roman Recipe and cook yourself a tasty treat! Write out the recipe using Roman Numerals instead of numbers for the measurements. Evaluate what you have made.	Retell the story of a Roman myth or legend and present it as a comic strip. Stories may include Romulus and Remus or Androcles and the Lion.
	Research a British Roman town and create a brochure for it as it is now e.g. Colchester. What is there to see and do? Why is it linked to the Roman era? Was it known by any other names?	Create your own maths game with a Roman theme. It could include countries of the Roman Empire. Roman towns in Britain or famous Roman buildings. It could perhaps use cards, counters, a spinner or dice with Roman Numerals.	Pompeii was an important city in the Roman Empire. Unfortunately, it sits on the site of a volcano. Map where these volcanos are in the world: Mauna Loa, Hawaii; Mount Fuji, Tokyo, Japan; Mayon Volcano, Philippines; Mount Kilimanjaro, Tanzania.
