

# Hello 5MP!



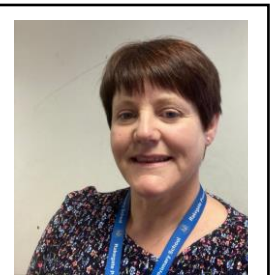
