	Create a 'Wanted Poster, which includes a description of the criminal, states what crime has been committed and what the punishment is. Use the website for help	Find out how many Vikings sailed in one longboat. A Viking raid would need 24 longboats. How many Vikings took part in one raid? What if $\frac{1}{4}$ of the boats sank, how many Vikings made it to the raid?	Research what clothes Anglo-Saxons wore. Find out how they made cloth, dyed it and made clothes to wear. Draw a picture of a family. Label their clothes.
	You are an archaeologist who has dug up a box of Anglo Saxon artefacts. What could be inside? Describe in a diary entry, using adjectives and similes what you found. Look at information about Sutton Hoo to help you.	Design 5 different circular Anglo Saxon shields and divide one into quarters, one into halves, one into thirds, one into sixths and one into eights. Colour and decorate them.	Look at the Fact Sheet. Write a paragraph to explain how life in the Anglo Saxon times was different to today. Give examples from the text to back up your ideas.

Challenge: Create and complete your own task related to your class topic: The Anglo-Saxons. This could be an Anglo-Saxon house, A shield, Artefacts - such as the Sutton Hoo Hoard.
