



English:

We will be practising sound recognition and how sounds are written within RWI. Children will begin to blend sounds into words and use their knowledge of phonics to assist with their spelling. This will be taught alongside our English lessons where we will share a range of texts including 'Little Red Riding Hood', 'Peace at Last' and 'Can't You Sleep Little Bear'. We will begin to write in simple sentences using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.



Creative Curriculum

Bright Lights, Big City

Put on your best clothes and shoes and get ready for a tea party with The Queen! What do you know about England's capital city? Let's find out all about London, including its history, transport and famous landmarks. Step back in time and discover what happened in the Great Fire of London. Where did it start? How did it end?

In Art and Design and Technology (DT), we will be looking at the primary colours, collages, and studying the artist Paul Klee. We will use the K'Nex to build some London landmarks. In DT lessons we will be designing and making souvenirs for the London Zoo.

In music, we will be learning to appraise pieces of music and making sound effects to accompany a poem or picture. We will also learn about high and low sounds.

In Religious education (RE) we will be learning about the Creation story and our beautiful world. We will also begin to look at the importance of Harvest time.

Maths:

- We will be learning to-
- Compare quantities and measures.
 - Introduce 'wholes' and 'parts'.
 - Looking at the composition of numbers to 5.
 - Recognise and name 2D and 3D shapes.
 - Looking at the composition of numbers 6-10.
 - Measure: length, height, weight and capacity.
 - Add numbers together.



Computing:

In Computing we will be using the iPads and the laptops to support our learning in other areas of the curriculum and research topics. We will also be looking at programming an interactive toy/robot to follow simple instructions in our Digital Programmer topic.



Science:

In Autumn 1, we will be learning about ourselves. We will recognise and name different parts of the human body. We will also begin to learn about our five senses. We will investigate what we use our senses for.

In Autumn 2, we will be learning about animals. We will name some common animals and begin to recognise their body parts. We will be looking at what animals eat and grouping and sorting animals.

British Values:

As part of British Values, we will be looking at who we are and what it means to be British. We will be discussing our role in the community, respect for everyone and caring for each other.

PE: Our PE will cover dance and games and we will be looking at throwing and catching and learning to follow instructions. In dance, we will be using space, using limbs in isolation, copying movements and varying speed and levels.
